

Directions for Registration 2008-2009

Front Side:

- Check student and parent information. Make corrections of address and phone numbers. If there is an address change, please send in a proof of address (ex. Housing contract or water, gas or power bill) with the registration sheet.
- Teacher Recommendation for next year. If you are not in agreement with the math placement for next year, please make note of it at the bottom of this form. This will serve as a waiver. Wake County states that a child must score an 85% on EOG for the waiver to be honored. If your child has scored appropriately on EOG and if class size will allow, we will honor your request for a change in placement. If those two criteria are not met, Dr. Dingle will have to approve the waiver.
- The Language Arts sections were not filled out by our teachers since they do not influence placement in classes. We do not have Advanced Language Arts classes because Lufkin is not a magnet school. Students who are identified AG will continue to have support. Mrs. Christesen provides lists of identified AG students each year to the faculty and monitors students' progress.
- Please make a note of any transfer or change of schools for next year. If you are planning on have your child return to the base school and did not indicate that on the intent form, you must apply for a transfer on line May 15-June 2. By letting us know in advance, we can assist in getting information to your child's new school. Thank-you!
- Look at your assignment strips closely on May 15. If you are not assigned to LRMS and wish to stay, please complete the transfer request on-line.
- If you would like to request a track change, forms will be available in the Guidance Office.
- Make any other pertinent notes or references at the bottom of the front side.

Back Side

Indicate interest in the Year long classes.

- To be in Band, one must have taken Band in the previous year(s). Otherwise, permission from Mrs. Simmons is required.
- If you have not taken Intro to Spanish, and you want one of those options, make sure to sign up for both of the Spanish options. If an Intro class is available, that is where you will be scheduled. If there is not one available and you mark the Spanish I class also, this tells me you want the yearlong class instead. If it is not marked, then this says to me you are only interested in the semester class and I will not schedule in the yearlong class.
- Spanish I has a prerequisite of Intro to Spanish. If you did not take Intro to Spanish as a 6th or 7th grader, you must have your Lang. Arts teacher's signature, and a Lang. Arts avg. grade of B+ or higher in order to take Spanish I. If an Intro to Spanish class is available, you will be scheduled in that class next year.
- Remember, CA is only for those students with an IEP.

Semester Long Classes
